An alpha SDK is expected by year's end, according to Nokia, and then the company will work with the open source community to create the beta SDK.

Maemo, first introduced in 2005, is one of the core platforms for Nokia's high-end products. Today maemo is the basis of the OS used in a range of Wi-Fi enabled Internet Tablets.
