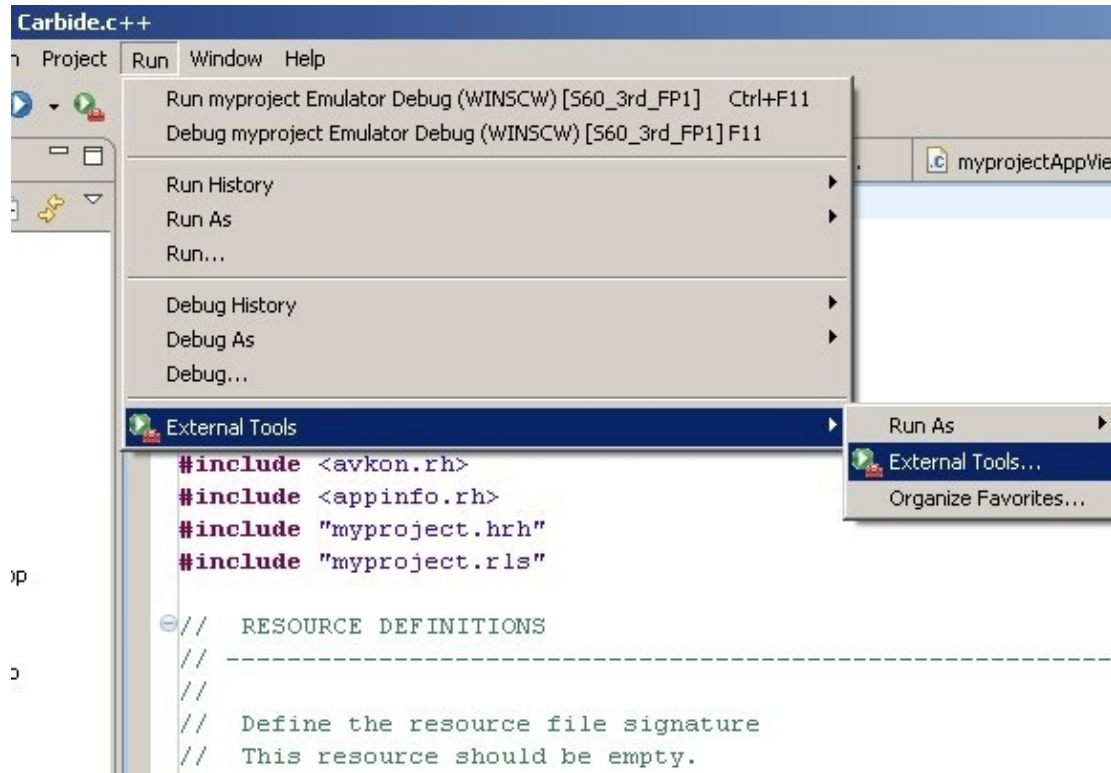
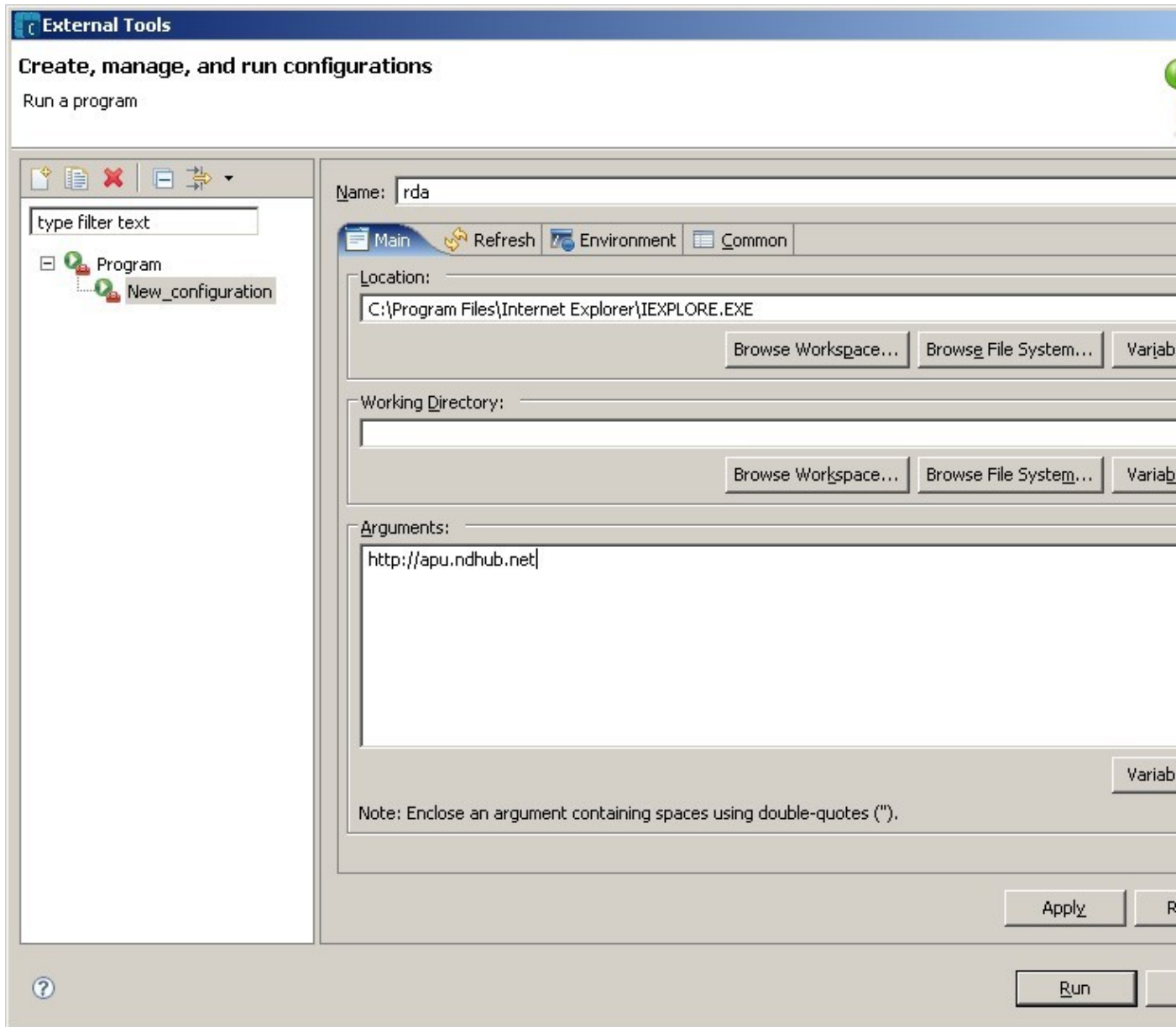


How_to_access_RDA_from_Carbide

The external tools tab in Carbide IDE can be useful in many cases. In this case you'll launch web browser with the Forum Nokia Remote Device Access service as parameter.



1. Go to Run->External tools->External tools from your Carbide IDE.



2. Create a new configuration. Select your preferred web browser to the location-field (IE used in the example) using the "Browse file system"-option. Write the direct address of the RDA service to the arguments field. The address is <http://apu.ndhub.net>. Save the settings and you're done.
